Do you know the Lord Jesus Christ as your savior?

Why do I need a savior? "For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God." (*Romans 3:23*)

"As it is written, There is none righteous, no, not one."
(*Romans 3:10*)

Where did sin come from?

"Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned." (*Romans 5:12*)

What are the consequences of sin?

"For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord." (*Romans 6:23*)

Jesus paid the price for our sins.

"But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us." (*Romans 5:8*)
