"I will hear what God the Lord will speak: for he will speak peace unto His people," (Psalms 85:8).

In the United States, more heterosexual brides are married in the month of June than any other month. The Presidents had 11 other months available from which they could have more sensitively chosen a LGBT Pride Month. Seemingly, they chose June in honor of June 28, 1969, the date of the first homosexual uprising during which the homosexual community physically fought against the US government. To the homosexual, June symbolizes the start of the Gay Rights Movement in the United States and around the world. To celebrate

Jesus Christ said, “Likewise also as it was in the days of Lot... Even thus shall it be in the day when the Son of Man is revealed,” (Luke 17:28-30). What was it like in Lot’s day before God destroyed Sodom and Gomorrah? It was “Even as Sodom and Gomorrah, and the cities about them in like manner, giving themselves over to fornication, and going after strange flesh, are set forth as an example, suffering the vengeance of eternal fire,” (Jude 7). Thus “fornication” (sex outside of marriage), and “going after strange flesh” (homosexuality), were the primary sins of those ancient cities.

For centuries June has been a big month for weddings. As far back as the Roman

Empire we find June set aside as the traditional bridal month. Juno was the Roman mythological goddess of women, marriage and childbirth. The Romans observed a festival in her honor on June first. As Christians we don’t follow pagan customs, but in some cases, after many centuries, they simply become part of the culture.

It is not surprising that Obama, whose Presidential campaign was thrust forward and heavily supported by the LGBT organizations, would make this subtle gesture of marriage inclusion into June as a gay month to please them.

Christians should love all people – including those who have chosen the path to homosexuality. Yet, we must at the same time stand on the scriptures that point to homosexuality as a sin:

- Leviticus 18:22: “Thou shalt not lie with mankind, as with womankind: it *is* abomination.”
- Leviticus 20:13: “If a man also lies with mankind, as he lieth with a woman, both of them have committed an abomination: they shall surely be put to death; their blood *shall be* upon them.”
- 1 Cor 6:9-10: “Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate (*root implies pedophilia*), nor abusers of themselves with mankind, Nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall inherit the kingdom of God.”

We must also understand that the Bible is clear that no one is born homosexual. Rather, homosexuality is a consequence of sin. In Romans 1:21, Paul teaches that people

become homosexual when they have glorified Him not as God, neither were thankful; but became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened.” In verse 26, Paul continues, “For this cause God gave them up unto vile affections: for even their women did change the natural use into that which is against nature: And likewise also the men, leaving the natural use of the woman, burned in their lust one toward another; men with men working that which is unseemly, and receiving in themselves that recompense of their error which was meet. And even as they did not like to retain God in their knowledge, God gave them over to a reprobate mind, to do those things which are not convenient.”

There is one marriage event that President Obama can never legislate. Jesus Christ has betrothed to himself those who are saved by His blood. He promises that they will one day become His Bride in Heaven. We don’t know the day or the time, but who knows, it could be some day in a month of June!

Bible-believing Christians worldwide look forward to the day when Christ will present them to Himself as a Bride without spot or wrinkle. Ephesians 5:27 speaks of believers as Christ’s Bride: “That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish.” “And the Spirit and the bride say, Come, And let him hearth say, Come. For many years it has been rumored that two homosexuals served as Bible consultants when the first New International Version (NIV) Committee set out to re-translate the Greek and Hebrew (1970-78) into a new English Bible. Here are the facts.

Dr. Virginia Mollenkott, served as literary critic on the NIV translation committee. Her biography reveals that she was aware of being a lesbian from age 11. Though she attended Bob Jones University, was married, birthed a son and then divorced, (during serving eight years on the NIV) she finally acknowledged her homosexuality publically and came out of the closet. Dr. Virginia Mollenkott confirmed her lesbian lifestyle when interviewed by the Episcopal magazine; *Witness* (June 1991, pp. 20-23). She admitted, "My homosexuality has always been a part of me." "Her reinterpretation of the Bible opened the way to reconciling feminism and her lesbian identity with Biblical teachings. Continuing to meld her Biblical beliefs with feminist and radical interpretations of the Bible, she co-authored *Is the Homosexual My*

Neighbor? and many similar books.

Also, a **second** homosexual who had much influence on the writing of the NIV. According to many sources, "The man appointed to be the Chairman of the Old Testament Committee of the NIV Committee on Bible Translation, Dr. Marten Woudstra, was a homosexual. . . . Some of Dr. Woudsta's collaborators on the NIV knew about this years ago during the translation process." http://www.jesus-is-savior.com/Bible/niv_sodomite_on_committee.htm. Is it any wonder that the word "sodomite" cannot be found in the NIV? Look it up-Deut. 23:17, I Kings 14:24, 15:12, 22:46, II Kings 23:7." Likewise, the words "effeminate" and "fornicator" are also missing. Jesus said that a corrupt tree brings forth evil fruit . . . "Even so every good tree bringeth forth good fruit; but a corrupt tree bringeth forth evil fruit," (Matthew 7:17). The sinful lifestyle of certain of the NIV translators clearly contributed to the production of a deeply flawed translation. The fruit they have born is the confusion, error and apostasy that now permeates churches using this Bible.

The Bible clearly teaches that the practice of homosexuality is a sin (Lev. 20:13; Rom. 1:18-27). We praise God that the sin of practicing homosexuality can be forgiven the same way any other sin is forgiven: by turning away from sin (repentance) and placing one's faith in Christ alone. Through Christ, anyone who is in bondage to the sin of homosexuality can be made a "new creature in Christ," (**2 Corinthians 5:17**) "...old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new." Bible Buyers Beware

Buying a new KJV Bible? Better check it out carefully.

One Amazon.com purchaser reports that the King James Bible that he was considering and found in a store was not God's true Word. As he leafed through it, he noticed that the first chapter of The Gospel According to John was missing verse one: "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God." He also found that verse two was listed as verse one. Very odd!

This particular KJV was published by the very ecumenical parachurch organization, the American Bible Society.

Some years ago I purchased, at a church bookstore, a KJV Bible which I later realized was full of typos and incorrect references. Just because a Bible is labeled KJV, it may not be trustworthy, depending on who publishes it. Two reliable Bible publishers are Cambridge University Press and B.B. Kirkbride Bible Company (publishers of the Thompson Chain Reference Bibles). []

Watching Our Words

Put Away Evil Speaking

“Let all bitterness, and wrath, and anger, and clamour, and evil speaking be put away from you,” Eph 4:31.

To ‘speak evil against’ is defined as *to slander; to call for mischief or injury to fall upon; to blaspheme; to swear; to utter impure words; bitter, wrathful speaking.* That’s quite an imposing list of sins! Several types of ‘evil speaking’ are found in four key New Testament passages:

- Col 3:8-9 (blasphemy, lying, filthy communications, wrath)
- Eph 5:4 (filthiness, foolish talking, jesting)
- Eph 4:31 (bitterness, wrath, anger, clamour)
- James 3:10 (cursing)¹

There are numerous scriptures that reveal the sinfulness of evil speaking. Yet, far too often, the “evil speaking” defined by Scripture just seems like everyday talk--expressions or conversations in which the average person normally takes part. Who hasn’t *complained often, even loudly, repeatedly, or urgently?* We usually do not think that we are “evil speaking” or “speaking clamorously” when we complain.

I guess that is our trouble, we don’t think! We also don’t apply God’s words to our words or His thoughts to our thoughts.

Most Christians cringe in the presence of blasphemy, course or crude jokes and the like, but who among us can stand before the Lord never having uttered words of bitterness, anger, lying or complaining or wishing ill toward someone? We need to ‘Watch Our Words’ toward each other. Those same words are spoken in front of both a Holy God and those who expect to see Jesus in us. Once aware of these sins, those of us who have a personal relationship with the Lord are blessed to have the conviction of the Holy Spirit to help us to clean up our attitudes. Repentance, apology and a heartfelt desire to change will clean up our mouths and souls.

Now Is the Best Time to Buy Gold -by Jacqueline Thorpe



Never before have there been so many gold merchants trying to convince people to “Buy Gold Now.” Some of the enticement slogans they use are: “Investing in gold is necessary to round out your investment portfolio “or “Gold is needed to guarantee against inflation and to guard against a falling dollar.” “Send for our *counseling* brochure or dial to speak to a gold investment *counselor*,” the companies advise.

But physical gold isn’t the gold that we most need – even in these tumultuous economic times. Revelation 3:18 tells us that God *counseled* the materialistic church members of Laodicea to seek spiritual gold over physical gold (Rev 3:14-20). Praise God that He is still offering *His* gold today right in the midst of Goldline International, Merit Financial and all the rest of the companies trying to sell the world’s gold.

Laodicea was a wealthy, sophisticated city located in what we now call the country of Turkey. God addresses the “gold issue” with this city and no other. He knew where their hearts were, i.e., with amassing wealth. Buying gold was probably as “in” in those days as it is in ours. Notice that God does not command the Laodiceans to buy His gold, but “*counsels*” them-another “today” word.

To the Laodiceans Jesus says in Rev 3:18 “I *counsel* thee to buy of me gold tried in the fire, that thou mayest be rich.”

What is God’s counsel against the tangible gold that they and we seek?

- “Your **gold** and silver is cankered; and the rust of them shall be a witness against you, and shall eat your flesh as it were fire. Ye have heaped treasure together for the last days,” (James 5:3). Just as people are doing now!
- Rev 3:17,18: “Because thou sayest, I am rich, and increased with goods, and have need of nothing; and knowest not that thou art wretched, and miserable, and poor, and blind, and naked. I counsel thee to buy of me gold tried in the fire, that thou mayest be rich.”
- Psalm 62:10: “If riches increase, set not your heart upon them.”
- Ecc 5:13, 14: “There is a sore evil which I have seen under the sun, namely, riches kept for the owners - thereof to their own hurt. But those riches perish by evil travail: and he begetteth a son, and there is nothing in his hand.

No one really knows how gold will hold its value in a financial crisis. It could be that there would be no solvent companies left to trade gold for currency. Is there any guarantee of economic salvation that gold can really offer?

Since God has made the statement, “It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle, than for a rich man to enter into the kingdom of God,” (Matt 19:24) we can understand God’s concern about the spiritual state of those hoarding riches and putting those riches before the eternal life that He can offer.

God has nothing against tangible gold. In the Book of Genesis He tells the people where to find gold. Throughout the Book of Leviticus He teaches man how

to decorate with gold. All through the Bible God speaks of the beauty of gold.

In Heaven we will walk on streets of gold and be given golden crowns to wear. It is when man puts tangible gold before spiritual gold that he is choosing to give up God’s eternal gold, both physical and spiritual.

God is trying to interest the Laodiceans of yesterday *and* today to buy a special kind of gold-that which has been purified by fire. He is offering us eternal gold which though free, may require testing, suffering and trials to purify it. 1 Peter 1:7 explains “*That the trial of your faith, being much more precious than of **gold** that perisheth, though it be tried with fire, might be found unto praise and honour and glory at the appearing of Jesus Christ.*”

How do we obtain God’s gold; the riches and wealth that He alone offers? Psalm 112: 1, 3 tells us, “*Blessed is the man that feareth the Lord,- that delighteth greatly in his commandments.*

Wealth and riches shall be in his house: and his righteousness endureth forever.” God’s gold represents righteousness and eternal life.

Those who give up their quest for physical gold (if it is a spiritual stumbling block) to buy gold from God, will gain a guaranteed golden eternity. []

Recognizing Error

How Did Family Radio Get So Far Away From Truth? -by Pastor Hammond

Harold Camping and his Family Radio network wrongly prophesied that “judgment day” would occur on May 21, 2011. Mr. Camping’s false prophesy proves that he speaks “the thing which the LORD hath not spoken,” (Deut. 18:22).

Mr. Camping’s departure from the truth is explained, in part, by his decision to resign his church membership in 1998. How does this explain his error? According to the Bible, local churches are the “pillar and ground of the truth,” (1 Timothy 3:15). Without the benefit of correction from fellow church members, Mr. Camping has strayed progressively further away from Biblical truth. His understanding has become so clouded that he’s proclaiming false prophesies. Perhaps more egregious, however, is his teaching that other believers “should not be part of a local church.” *He’s perpetuating his error by calling others away from the very place where they might be corrected!*

The Family Radio website states “... we are now compelled to teach the Biblical truth that God has shifted the final task of world evangelism to individual Christians who are outside of a local congregation. In obedience to these Biblical teachings, Family Radio, which is completely outside of any church institution, and which is supported and administered by individual believers, does teach that today, as we are heading for the end of this world’s existence, we should not be a part of a local church,” (Accessed May 18, 2011). Camping is wrongly teaching believers to depart from the very institutions that God has ordained for our instruction and correction! In the New Testament, all ministries are carried-out in and through local church. For example, Paul was sent out by a local church (Acts 13) to plant local churches. Wherever people were saved, Paul both baptized and discipled those believers. Paul also taught that men should be ordained to

fill the two offices of local churches: elder/bishop/pastor (Titus 1:5) and deacons (1 Timothy 3).

The conversion of the chief ruler of the synagogue at Corinth, Crispus, demonstrates that membership in a local church is God's plan for New Testament believers. In Acts 13, Luke records that Paul preached the gospel to Crispus and others at Corinth (18:1-7). As a result of Paul's preaching, Crispus and others believed. (18:8). Paul then baptized Crispus and the other believers (Acts 18:8; 1 Cor. 1:14) into the “one body” at Corinth (1 Corinthians 12:13). After baptizing the new believers, Paul remained at Corinth to disciple the new church members for “a year and six months, teaching the word of God among them,” (1 Cor 18:11).

Later, Paul also wrote two inspired epistles “...unto the church of God which is at Corinth...” In his first letter to the church at Corinth, Paul taught the baptized church members to observe the Lord's Supper, i.e. he taught the ordinances of the local church. In all of these facts, it may be observed that Paul had a deep commitment to the Lord’s plan to establish local churches and to edify believers in those churches.

For Harold Camping to call believers out of local churches is to call them out of God’s plan for His people. It is to call believers away from the place where we “...fitly framed together groweth unto an holy temple in the Lord: In whom ye also are builded together for an habitation of God through the Spirit,” (Ephesians 2:21-22).

Pray for Harold Camping. And pray for other believers who have resisted being baptized into one of our Lord’s local assemblies. Today, let’s recommit ourselves to serving in and through the local church where God has placed us! God Promises to Preserve His Words So That We May Keep His Words

The Psalms help us to understand two great truths regarding the Bible: (1) The Bible is the word of God and (2) God has preserved His words so that we may obey them today. These ideas are brought together in a single verse: “Concerning thy testimonies, I have known of old that thou hast founded them for ever,” (Psalm 119:152). There, the psalmist credits God with both supplying his testimonies (inspiring His words) and with preserving them “for ever.”

The New Testament also credits the LORD with breathing out (inspiring) all the words of both the Old Testament and the New Testament. “For the prophecy came not in old time by the will of man: but holy men of God spake as they were moved by the Holy Ghost,” (2 Pet 1:21). “All scripture is given by inspiration of God ...,” (2 Timothy 3:16).

The Bible is also filled with promises that the LORD preserves His words for His people. “The words of the LORD are pure words: as silver tried in a furnace of earth, purified seven times. Thou shalt keep them, O LORD, thou shalt preserve them from this generation for ever,” (Psalm 12:6-7). In the New Testament, Peter reiterated that the “the word of the Lord endureth for ever,” (1 Peter 1:25). And Jesus also spoke great promises about the preservation of His words. Jesus said, “For verily I say unto you, Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law, till all be fulfilled,” (Matthew 5:18). Later, He promised that “Heaven and earth shall pass away, but my words shall not pass away,” (Matthew 24:35).

Why is the LORD’s promise to preserve His words so very important? It is because the LORD promised to preserve the words of the Bible, that the psalmist was able to proclaim, “I shall keep thy testimonies,” (Ps. 119:146). Today, we too may obey God’s words only because we have access to all of God’s preserved words.

Sadly, the truth that God promises to preserve His words is lacking from the teaching of many otherwise sound churches.

Consequently, many of those churches have been duped into accepting modern Bible translations produced by secular scholars who reject the doctrine of preservation. Because those scholars reject the doctrine of preservation, they have advanced scholarship as the proper method for determining the true words of God. Their scholarly efforts have produced modern Bible translations that attempt to question or eliminate entire verses of the Bible --obscuring the very testimonies that God has called us to keep!

Instead, God’s people should hold fast to God’s promises and simply receive the Bible texts that have been traditionally received by God’s people. At Long Hill Baptist Church, we desire to hold firmly to all of God’s words. That is a key reason why we use the *Authorized King James Bible* – the most accurate translation of the inspired and preserved words of God. Praise God that He keeps His word so that we may keep His words!

The Danger of Using Scripture Out of Context.

Popular “New Apostolic Reformation” (NAR) apostle/preacher, heretic, C. Peter Wagner, has developed a lucrative conference called *Finaceial K.E.Y.S.*, based on Proverbs 13:22. He teaches that money is the key to global transformation and establishing God’s Kingdom on earth. Wagner quotes the Proverb as, “The wealth of the wicked is laid up for the just.”

The **New Apostolic Reformation** is a movement which asserts that God is restoring the lost offices of church governance, namely the offices of Prophet and Apostle. It is a movement in Protestant Christianity largely associated with the Pentecostal and Charismatic movements.

The conference claims that the wealth of the wicked will be supernaturally transferred to believers. However, in context the verse says, “A good man leaveth an inheritance to his children’s children: and the wealth of the sinner is laid up for the just.” Those who don’t check their Bibles could fall for spiritual scams. Beware of teachings by C. Peter Wagner. []

HOW CAN I BE SURE OF HEAVEN?

How can I be sure of Heaven ?

1. Acknowledge to God that you have sinned against Him. The Bible says, "For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;" (Romans 3:23).
2. Realize that our sin separates us from God. "For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord." (Romans 6:23)
3. Understand that Christ died on the cross and paid for all our sins. "For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast.." (Ephesians 2:8-9).

4. The Bible teaches that, in order to receive forgiveness of sins, we must repent and place our faith in Christ.
