Do you know the Lord Jesus Christ as your savior?

Why do I need a savior? “For all have sinned and come short of the glory of God.” (*Romans 3:23*)

“As it is written, There is none righteous, no not one.”
(*Romans 3:10*)

Where did sin come from?

“Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin, and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned.” (*Romans 5:12*)

What are the consequences of sin?

“For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.” (*Romans 6:23*)
